MULTI MEDIA PANELS



An exciting method of exploring a variety of medium including paint, pastels, mosaic, tiles, shells, fabrics and paper to striking effect. 'The Beach' - Degas, was recreated by KS1 & KS2 children using pre-sized card to reproduce their section of the master image resulting in an eye-catching three dimensional artwork.



PAINT STUDIES

The Beach - As part of the 'Take One Picture' nationwide competition, the children of Friars studied 'The Beach' by Degas. We worked with Year 5 & 6 pupils to create a modern day interpretation, painting onto a sizeable canvas using a vibrant range of professional acrylics.



Beach Studies - The children enjoyed a day at the beach taking photographs from which these studies were created. Working with Year 4 & 5 pupils, we encouraged the children to examine different textures and elements within the photographs before demonstrating different techniques - mixing wet paint onto canvas.



Flying Books - A series of four vibrant canvas panels produced by the pupils of Eastwood for their school library. We developed a theme of books coming to life and worked with the pupils to produce the initial design and the final acrylic painted canvasses.
